

Parks & Open Space Seasonal Ranger

The Parks and Open Space Seasonal Ranger is responsible for providing an efficient customer service-oriented experience. This is achieved by ensuring a well-maintained environment and quick response to the general public needs. This position works under the direct supervision of the Lead Park Ranger but will receive specific instruction on non-routine tasks. Duties include:

- Patrol parks, trails, green spaces and other open spaces by motor vehicle, bicycle or foot.
- Monitor and enforce proper use of City facilities, parks, and open spaces by public users.
- Report discrepancies, problems, recommendations and needed maintenance to the Parks and Recreation Lead Park Ranger.
- Educate and advise the public on City ordinances and policies relating to park and open space use.
- Log and report contacts with unsheltered individuals to the Lead Park Ranger.
- Maintain daily patrol log
- Patrol designated areas throughout the City at specified times as a deterrent to vandalism.
- Must be available to work a flexible schedule including evenings, weekends, and holidays.
- Supplement Parks and Recreation staff for activities as needed.
- Monitor two-way radio.
- Responsible for answering general questions from the public regarding park amenities.
- Perform occasional maintenance duties as needed.
