Parks Maintenance Worker

Under the direct supervision of the Director of Maintenance, this position provides assistance with the general upkeep, and maintenance related activities within all the Parks and Recreation Departments areas within the city.. Those activities include but are not limited to, operating various trucks, tractor, and mowers in grounds maintenance work as well as maintaining and repairing Parks and Recreation facilities. Trash removal, parks cleanup, event setup plus all other duties related to the department. This shall be accomplished in compliance with established local, state, and federal standards. As work experience is gained, employee may be assigned to somewhat more difficult tasks. This is a 35-40 hour per week position with a pay range of \$15.54 to \$20.89 per hour. The duration of this position can range from 3 to 10 months.

Athletic Maintenance Worker

Under the direct supervision of the Athletic Field Maintenance Supervisor, this position provides assistance with a variety of maintenance related activities with a variety of athletic playing fields around the City. Sports fields must be maintained daily to provide safe and playable areas for all users. Duties include watering, weed removal, dragging, setting bases, lines, as well as repairing dirt and turf surfaces; assisting with custodial duties, restroom cleaning, litter control, and complex inspection activities, identify and refer any needed repairs discovered at any location, ability to operate a variety of power equipment including riding mowers, motorized utility carts, and other pieces of equipment as needed.
